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Wine scores can be very useful when purchasing wines at auction. Auctions can present good opportunities to purchase rare and expensive bottles, and the opportunity to taste some “new to you” vintages.

A wine score is often the simplest and quickest way for a wine critic to communicate their considered opinion about the quality of a wine. Tasting notes typically accompany the wine scores, helping consumers and collectors decide what wines to buy.

Wine scoring is typically done on a 100-point scale:

Score	Explanation
95-100	Classic: a great wine
90-94	Outstanding: a wine of superior character and style
85-89	Very good: a wine with special qualities
80-84	Good: a solid, well-made wine
75-79	Mediocre: a drinkable wine that may have some flaws
50-74	Not recommended

Robert Parker implemented the 100 point scale in the 1980s but also notes that a highly rated bottle will not guarantee personal enjoyment. He urges buyers to pay attention to a wine’s tasting notes in addition to the scores.

Perhaps, and most importantly, everyone’s palate and tastes are different. Although Hall’s Auction Services Ltd. has engaged specialists to assist with the cataloguing of the wines offered, we cannot guarantee that you will enjoy every bottle purchased. All wines are consigned from “well-cellar’d” collections but are sold on an “as is” basis. We do not accept consignments that, in our opinion, have been stored in questionable conditions, or where we cannot verify cellaring.

A quick work on “corked” wines: estimates vary on how significant the issue is. The cork industry has estimated that around 1% of all wines are affected, but other estimates have ranged between this and 8%. Cork taint occurs in the winery and is impossible to detect prior to opening a bottle. For this reason, no lot can be guaranteed to be free of cork taint.

While browsing our catalogue, you will note that we may have included tasting notes and/or critic ratings.

Distillery Bottled
700 ml / Islands Single Malt / 55.8% ABV

"The nose leans sweet with dulce de leche and dark berry jam, but it's countered with dark chocolate, dried rose petals, and a faint whiff of talc. The palate is thick with raisins, figs, candied ginger, orange peel, Concord grape jelly, rose oil, cocoa, and peppery spice, while the lengthy finish has persistent white pepper, dried ginger, chocolate, and burnt citrus. Dense with flavor thanks to its total sherry-cask maturation; give it time to fully reveal its depths. 94/100"

The 18 year is bottled in small batches, using both bourbon hogshead and sherry butts. Benrinnes, sometimes compared to Mortlach, has a very earthy almost herbal side. Truly a great value from A.D. They remain so on the palate, integrating beautifully with chocolate cake sweetness. You’re on the isle of Islay with this one, all right. Light and subtle once more on the finish, with fruit notes emerging and the peat fading long down the road. 94/100” - Whisky Advocate

This release is a pre-Morrison’s vintage, distilled back in 1957. The microclimate of the No.1 Vaults warehouse at Bowmore distillery means casks share very little with the angels, and has allowed the distillery to bottle some spectacular age-statements over the years. This spent 38 years in it before a falling ABV necessitated bottling before it crossed the 40% threshold that negates the single malt classification.

The bottle is displayed in an individual oak presentation case, hand crafted by the Master Cabinet Makers of Charles Kirkby & Sons of Sheffield, England. Each case has an individually numbered brass plaque which corresponds with the bottle number on the back label.

"The GlenDronach started its Grandeur series back in 2010. It is a selection of some of the best and oldest Oloroso casks in the warehouses, roughly between 25 and 30 years of age. In 2023 they released Grandeur Batch 12. We can't be sure, but this should be 1993 or 1994 stock.

Nose: how nice! Beautiful polished oak, superb tobacco notes and rosewood. Red berries, juicy plums, raspberry ganache and blackcurrant. A dollop of rustic cognac rancio, as well as soft hints of graphite. Then rum and raisins, cinnamon, drops of balsamic and spiced chocolate. Later also a combination of dark coffee and fresh mint, which works wonders.

Mouth: a great sweet and sour balance, without any oaky astringency. Plums and figs, along with sultanas, cherries, roasted coffee beans and milk chocolate. Then raspberry jam, candied ginger and old leather. Cinnamon, walnuts and tobacco. Clean, bright sherry that brings back memories of 1970s 'Dronach.

Finish: rather long, with more juicy fruits, coffee, orange peels and old oak. 92/100" - Whisky Notes
