

"Woman, Dog and Canoe" is one of the most famous serigraphs created by Atlantic artist Alexander Colville. Colville began working with the silkscreen process in the 1950s, and produced thirty-five unique series of prints throughout his career between 1956 and 2002. All were original compositions that were separate entities from his paintings. In 1985, a catalogue of Colville's prints was produced, using "Woman, Dog and Canoe" as the cover image.

Colville often used his wife, Rhoda, as his model, and the various pets of the Colville family appeared in his compositions throughout his entire career. With strength and grace, the female figure stands paddling on the serene lake, moving with intent through gentle waters as her canine companion keeps watch ahead.
